Environment / Task / Activity	Level of risk	Control Measures	Review date	Review outcome
Arrival / departure	L	Josie brought into school either by mother or taxi driver at 8.45 am. Taken to the Hive. At end of day, Josie taken to taxi, or to the Hive where met by mother. Collected by mother on dance club nights. Accompanied by staff / sixth form student before, during and after dance club.		
Corridors / stairs	L	Accompanied by Teaching Assistant between lessons. One way system operates on stairs and corridors at busy times. Option is available to move between lessons before the bell goes.		
PE	L	TA assists with changing. If Josie falls during lesson, PE staff are on hand to assist.		
Breaks / lunchtimes	L	TA support throughout during transition. Josie to eat her lunch in the Hive until such time as she is more able to deal with her frustrations without scratching others.		
Physiotherapy exercises / exercises requested by parents	L	Demonstration, advice and monitoring of appropriate exercise programme by physiotherapist. Suggested therapy of walking Josie blindfolded up and down stairs rejected as being too dangerous for any Ringwood student to undertake even with supervision. Suggest that Josie's doctor be consulted for further advice.		
School trips	L-M	1:1 support by TA. Fieldwork Risk Assessment carried out by staff leading trip prior to school trip.
